***Sawyer Brown and Eve 6 Join the Antelope Island Stampede
Labor Day Week-End September 3 - 5, 2010***

Thousands of people will be making their way to Antelope Island this Labor Day week-end for the biggest event ever held on the island.

The Antelope Island Stampede - previously known as the Balloon and Kite Stampede - is a three-day event, packed full of fun. In addition to balloons and kites, organizers promise vendors, food and local entertainment, and for the first time, nationally acclaimed ***BIG TIME*** entertainers.

Taking their name from the Nashville street where they once rehearsed, Sawyer Brown made their national TV debut on the show Star Search in 1984. They continued recording and touring the country for the next seventeen years and completed 17 albums. Sawyer Brown was one of the first country acts to use music videos. Original members include lead vocalist Mark Miller, keyboardist Gregg (Hobie) Hubbard, drummer Joe Smyth and bassist Jim Scholten.

Sawyer Brown takes the main stage Saturday night September 4th at 9:00 P.M.

"Eve 6" is an American Rock band from Southern California who are most well known for their hits "Inside Out", "Leech" and the slow anthem "Here's to the Night". Their basic rock trio (guitar/bass/drums) sound is augmented on their later studio recordings with many interesting studio techniques. The members are Max Collins (vocals, bass, guitar and piano), Tony Fagenson drums / percussion and Matt Bair (guitar, backing vocals). Eve 6 will no doubt pack 'em in Friday night Sept 3rd at 9:00 P.M. on the main stage with fireworks (literally).

Tickets for the event continue to be \$10.00 per carload for entrance to the island which includes all event activities other than the two concerts on the main stage. Tickets for both main-stage concerts are available through SmithsTix.
